### **Takeaways**

- From 2016 to 2021, jobs increased by 1.2% in Huron, SD from 11,691 to 11,828. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 0.4% by 1.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 69.1% to 70.5% between 2016 and 2021.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.6% of Huron, SD residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.7% below the national average), and **11.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2021 are Animal Slaughtering and Processing, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Crop Production.











# **Unemployment by Ethnicity**





As of 2021 the region's population increased by 1.6% since 2016, growing by 323. Population is expected to decrease by 1.0% between 2021 and 2026, losing 209.






# **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Huron, SD had a November 2021 unemployment rate of 1.98%, decreasing from 2.59% 5 years before.






#### Millennials

Huron, SD has 3,569 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,224.




#### **Retiring Soon**

#### **Racial Diversity**


Racial diversity is low in Huron, SD. The national average for an area this size is 8,256 racially diverse people, while there are 4,994 here.

Huron, SD has 2.29 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.62 per 1,000 people.




#### **Property Crime**








## **Top Industry Location Quotient**







### **Top Occupation Location Quotient**









